Our board is made up of local people who help ensure the TMO is listening to local needs. The board decide how we spend our money and help set targets for the organisation.

Any Clapton Park Estate, Nye Bevan Estate or Millfields Estate resident over the age of 18 can become a member of the TMO and stand for election as a board member. It doesn't matter what skills, qualifications or experiences you have, we just need local people who want to work with us to make Clapton Park an even better place to live.

To help you decide if you would like to stand for election to the board we have provided a list of the duties required of board members:

- To work with other board members and our housing management team to create a housing organisation to be proud of.
- To ensure CPMO is compliant with its governing documents, Company Law and any other relevant legislation
- To ensure CPMO's financial stability
- To ensure effective administration of CPMO
- To protect and manage the property of CPMO and ensure proper investment of funds
- To actively contribute to giving strategic direction to CPMO, set policies, define goals, set targets and evaluate performance against set targets.
- To ensure monitor and appraise CPMO's Head of Operations
- To consult with members, residents and other key stakeholders



Being a board member involves:

- Attending board meetings once a month
- Taking an active role in discussions about improving the service
- Making decisions on how CPMO is run
- Getting the chance to take part in Sub-Committees and Sub-groups
- Complying with CPMO's Code of Conduct
